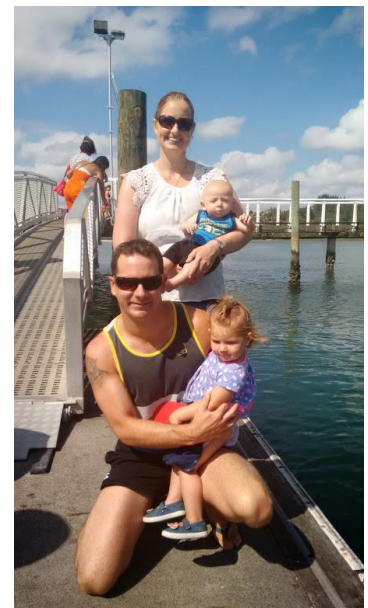
Personal Note
