### PROGRESS TO DATE

Hopefully in the next two weeks we will have the finalised plans back from the architect. These will need to be thoroughly gone through in regards to fittings, finishing's etc., and then they will need to be confirmed. Once that has happened, the next step is the building consent process, which we expect to take approximately 20days. This has taken longer than expected and now means the first stage of moving the church and vicarage is likely to be delayed till mid-September as Joel and Susanne are expecting their first child in early July and it is not suitable to move the house in the first couple of months after the birth.



Since the last newsletter we have finalised the lease agreement for the land with the diocese. The Trust website ([www.terongopai.org.nz](http://www.terongopai.org.nz)) has been set up and gone live. We also currently have a grant application in with a Trust seeking \$150,000 for the project. Please pray with us that this application will be received favourably and that the Trust will come on board.
